If you were The Doctor what kind of doctor would you be? What would you wear? What would your catchphrase be?





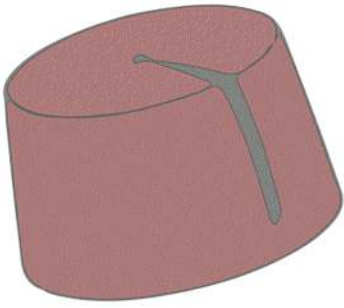
Whovian Writing Ideas

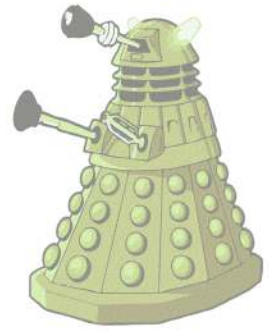

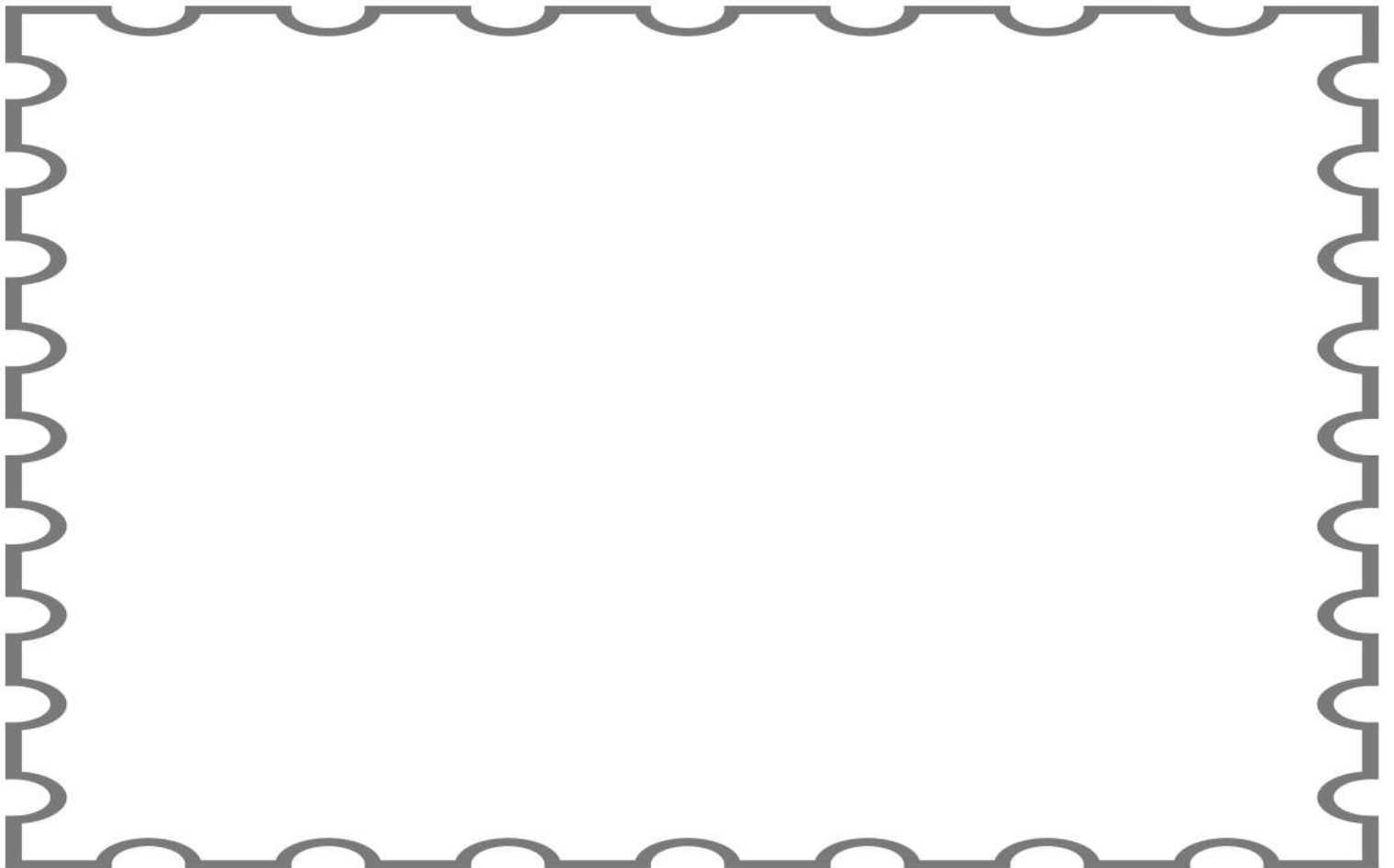
